"Put means to place a thing where you want it. Putt means merely a vain attempt to do the same thing."

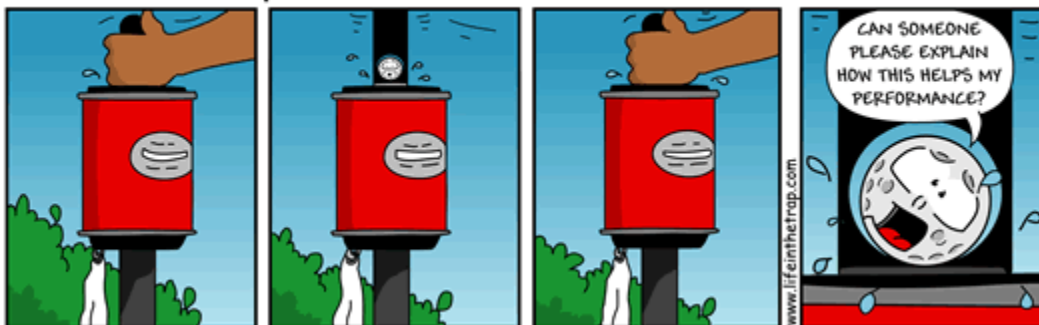
