Marking your Ball when on the Green:

Place the marker behind the ball and then lift your ball. When placing your ball place the ball in front of the ball marker and lift the ball marker. The ball marker should be right up against the ball. Anything else is CHEATING.

Gimme Putts when on the Green:

Example: I am on the green and putting for a bogey (5) and it rolls 35 feet and stops 6 inches from the hole. The other team gives me the putt. The score is not a Bogey(5) it is a 6 as the gimme counts as one. Anything else is CHEATING.
