## NUWC Golf Employees League Special Edition Kickoff Bulletin 30 March 2018

### **News**

Welcome back to all the dedicated league members from previous years and a special welcome to all those who agreed to take on a Captainship, the subs that took the leap to be regulars and for all the new players supporting our league in 2018. Although we really haven't hit Spring even if the calendar says so **we will start the season on 12**April. Taking a page out of the DJT playbook, I figured I'd just tweet my way through introducing you to the 2018 season. I encourage you to read below as there are a few important changes from last year but also a lot that stayed the same. Before I start my twitter rant, the biggest change is a rule change that I will provide first:

17.3. Ball Lost or Out of Bounds (Local Rule -Alternative Stroke and Distance) - When a player's ball cannot be found or is virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed as follows rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. There will be no provisional balls hit:

For two penalty strokes, the player may take relief by dropping the original ball or a substituted as shown below.



### **Example:**

- a. If you choose to use this local rule after your initial stroke off the tee box, you would be taking relief and lying 3, hitting 4. If your tee shot was in play and you hit out of bounds or have a lost ball on your 2<sup>nd</sup> shot, you'd be lying 4 hitting 5, etc., etc.
- b. If you choose to hit a 2nd ball off the tee, you will be hitting 3 and abandon the first ball hit (even if you find it). If both the initial stroke off the tee and 2<sup>nd</sup> shot go OB or are lost, you must use this local rule that would leave you lying 5, hitting 6, because the 2<sup>nd</sup> ball is the ball in play.

Once a player leaves the region where the original ball was last played, they forfeit the option to use stroke and distance relief (cannot go back to the tee or last spot hit from) and must proceed under the above ruling or any other applicable options - this includes removal of the stroke-and-distance option for all hazards.

#### **Application case study:**

Hole 3 - Tee shot goes into trees on right. You can re-tee, hitting 3, or drop up ahead using the new USGA guidelines of drop location options hitting 4. As soon as you leave the tee box area, you can ONLY use the new rule.

You now have 2 options when you hit a shot OOB/Lost/Unplayable area - use of stroke and distance (until you leave the original shot area) or the new 2-stroke penalty drop

Captains should inform all retirees and non-NUWC members on their teams to use the website for all League information.

# <u>Dues – Even though the dues are listed in the rules, they are</u> repeated here as additional encouragement for you to pay on time!

League dues for regulars will be \$40/year, payment received by 10 May 2018. Payment increases to \$45.00 if received after 10 May 2018. Members are responsible for paying their own dues. Payments can be made to Barbara Keller (Treasurer) or to any other League Official. Make checks payable to "NUWC Golf League". Cash will also be accepted. Please read the rules as there will be reduction in points penalties assessed to teams that have members who have not paid by 24 May 2018. Additionally, members who do not pay by the date indicated are subject to removal as a member and will be placed on the Sub List. Their position on the Team roster will be filled by the next eligible individual on the Sub List based upon membership criteria (frequency of filling in as a sub and handicap with respect to division roster spot needing to be filled). Team Captains are encouraged to ensure all Team Members pay their dues in a timely manner.


